Convention News:

Origins, June 23rd to 27th, 2010. In Columbus Ohio.

We have (Thanks to Tim Kennard) an entire series of Dragon Storm events in the show. In addition we will have an official Demo table in the open gaming area at the Con. This will bring us to our normal situation of having to find and arrange GM's for the show. I know Tim has been trying to get things set up, but this is a perpetual challenge for us. What we are going to need is volunteers to keep the Demo Table staffed and operational. I have ordered a print run of the Standard Card Set 5 Character to have available and we will have decks available.

To keep things interesting at the Con, **Sue will only be at the Origins show on Thursday**. On Friday she has to run the booth at Anthrocon. That means she and I leave Origins Thursday night and head on over to Pittsburgh. On Friday morning we set up the Anthrocon booth. On Friday afternoon I will head back to Origins. My shining face should actually reappear on Saturday. Tim, Ann and Lee will be keeping an eye on the booth Friday for us. With them tied down you can see why we need GM help.

Susan will be landing at the con Friday morning. During the weekend she will be running her booth and accepting at show commissions and debuting a number of new furry prints.
